1. What are the dates of Kidney Week 2023?

- **Wednesday, October 25** – On-demand content for all [Early Programs](#) except the Advances in Research Conference available in the ASN eLearning Center.
- **Wednesday, November 1** – In-person sessions in Philadelphia for all [Early Programs](#).
- **Thursday, November 2, through Sunday, November 5** – ASN Annual Meeting in-person sessions, posters, exhibits, and more in Philadelphia.
- **Late November** – All meeting content will be available in the ASN eLearning Center for in-person participants and Kidney Week On-Demand purchasers.

2. What is the time zone of Kidney Week 2023?

Eastern Daylight/Savings Time (EDT/EST) in the United States. Please note that EDT changes to EST during the meeting on Sunday, November 5, at 2:00 a.m.

3. What does Kidney Week 2023 include?

- **Seven in-person Early Programs:** [Advances in Research Conference](#), [Fundamentals of Renal Pathology](#), [Genetics in Clinical Nephrology](#) (NEW), [Glomerular Diseases](#), [Kidney Transplantation](#), [Maintenance Dialysis](#), [Nephrocardiology](#) (NEW). All have in-person sessions in Philadelphia on Wednesday, November 1. All but the Advances in Research Conference have on-demand content available on Wednesday, October 25. Each Early Program has a separate registration fee and offers continuing education credits. Participants must attend in-person to claim continuing education credits.
- **ASN Annual Meeting (November 2–5):** All sessions, posters, and exhibits will take place in-person in Philadelphia. All meeting content will be available in the ASN eLearning Center in late November.

Access code information will be provided in October. Individuals who did not attend in-person may purchase Kidney Week On-Demand in late November. The call for late-breaking clinical trials will open on Wednesday, July 19, and close on Wednesday, September 6, at 2:00 p.m. EDT.

10. How will posters be viewed, presented, etc.?

Posters will be presented in-person in Philadelphia on Thursday, November 2, Friday, November 3, and Saturday, November 4, from 9:30 a.m. – 2:30 p.m. EDT (each day) in the exhibit hall. If accepted for poster presentation, an author must be available at the poster board at 10:00 a.m. – 12:00 p.m. EDT for presentation and discussion. Posters should also be uploaded as ePosters for viewing on-demand starting Thursday, November 2, at 10:00 a.m. EDT.

11. Will there be an exhibit hall?

Kidney Week 2023 includes in-person exhibits in Philadelphia on Thursday, November 2, Friday, November 3, and Saturday, November 4, from 9:30 a.m. – 2:30 p.m. EDT (each day). There are no virtual exhibits.

17. What is the vaccination policy for in-person participants?

All in-person participants, including but not limited to attendees, exhibitors, staff, and vendors, are encouraged to be fully vaccinated for COVID-19. All participants during registration are required to agree to Assumption of Risk, Code of Conduct, and Terms and Conditions.

18. Will there be continuing education credits (CME/CNE/CPE) and maintenance of certification (MOC) points for Kidney Week 2023? If so, how many credits/points?

Annual Meeting participants and Kidney Week On-Demand learners can claim up to 75 continuing education (CE) credits, American Board of Internal Medicine (ABIM) MOC points, and American Board of Pediatrics (ABP) MOC points. For Early Programs, CE credits vary from program to program, and MOC points are not offered.

19. How can I get my Certificate of Attendance?

Early Program participants can pick up *printed* Certificates of Attendance (not CE certificates for US participants) on Wednesday, November 1, at the programs. Annual Meeting participants can access *online* Certificates of Attendance (not CE certificates for US participants) starting November 2, 2023, through February 2, 2024. More information on how to access the online certificate will be available in late October. The online certificate is only available if you have picked up your meeting materials or printed your meeting badge onsite.

20. Will there be social events at Kidney Week 2023?

ASN will host a Welcome Reception open to all in-person participants in the exhibit hall on Thursday, November 2, 6:00 p.m. – 7:00 p.m. EDT.
